## TECHNOLOGY USE POLICY/AND USER'S AGREEMENT

In an effort to educate students about "long distance" learning and the importance of data communications and networks, the parents of Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah members must become partners with Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah. Members will be using the Internet along with scientists, researchers, and other professionals. In this document Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah states its policies for ethical, responsible use of technology. However, ultimately the parents of minors are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their students should follow.

Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah staff are very concerned that our members learn and practice responsible and ethical use of the Internet. Members and parents who accept and agree to the rules of this agreement have a direct obligation to adhere to the standards expected by Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah. **Any irresponsible conduct will lead to termination of the users' access and could cause a great loss to our Club, our Club members, staff and community members.** It is hoped that our members will be leaders in the effective, responsible use of the Internet as a research and communications tool.

In order to use the Internet at Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah, you must agree to responsible use of the technology resources available. This includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Not engaging in illegal or questionable activities such as "hacking" transmitting or storing copyrighted materials, using obscenities, viewing or transferring pornographic materials, or harassing other users.
- Not using the Internet for commercial purposes.
- Immediately ceasing any activity deemed inappropriate by staff.

### **ACCESS TO THE INTERNET IS NOT A RIGHT AND CAN BE REVOKED AT ANY TIME.**

Do not assume that your communications are private. Understand that there are adult-related resources on the net which are inappropriate for member access, and which the members need to avoid.

All who wish to access the Internet at Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah must sign below indicating they fully understand their responsibility and agreement with the standards stated above. If you are under 18 years of age, you must have your parent or guardian's signature.

Boys & Girls Club of Ukiah believes that the benefits to staff, members and community from access to the Internet, in the form of information, resources, and opportunities for collaboration, far exceed any disadvantages of access. However, our Club supports and respects each families right to decide whether or not to apply for network access by signing or not signing this document.

# DISCIPLINARY POLICY

**FIRST VIOLATION:**

- RECEIVE A VERBAL WARNING

Examples but not limited to: running inside, yelling or name calling at another member, being disruptive during meetings or Power Hour, being disrespectful toward staff or members, rude behavior.

**SECOND VIOLATION:**

- TIME-OUT
- WRITTEN WARNING WITH PARENT NOTIFICATION

Examples but not limited to: repeated violations after verbal warning.

**THIRD VIOLATION:**

- SUSPENSION (LENGTH DEPENDING UPON SEVERITY OF VIOLATION)

Examples but not limited to: after speaking to parent, member continues with behavior.

ISSUES PERTAINING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: VIOLENCE, VERBAL HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION OR SEXUAL HARASSMENT VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION AND POSSIBLE REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP (EXPULSION).
